

Apple 'Adore'™

Description

Bred by Delbard Nurseries, France.

Apple 'Adore' is naturally disease resistant, so is perfect for organic growing and the fruit will be clean of blemishes.

The fruit is a mid season variety (ripening in April in Nelson). It is tasty, crisp and juicy - and stores well for 2-3 months. It is highly productive, with fruit usually produced in the second summer after planting.

Current stock is grown on dwarf rootstock, so grows to just 2m tall.

Growing Situation and Care Notes

Best in free draining soil with strong tree support. Good disease resistance so requires minimal spraying. Plant in full sun. Compact to suit smaller gardens.

Planting Guide:

1. Select a sunny site with fertile soil and good drainage.
2. Dig hole about 30cm deep.
3. Set tree on hole at same height as planted in bag.
4. Fill hole with soil.
5. Mulch and water around the base of the tree.
