

Dwarf Apple 'Blush Babe'™

Description

The first natural dwarf apple to be available to New Zealand gardeners - and what a beauty! From the prestigious Delbard Nursery in France, this variety is ideal for patio pots, for planting in small gardens and potages. The red fruit is crispy and juicy - delicious eaten freshly picked. The perfect plant for children to look after and pick the fruit from. Deciduous.

Growing Situation and Care Notes

Little or no pruning is required. Good disease resistance so requires minimal spraying.

Great for planting in containers, potages and smaller gardens. Plant in full sun.

Pollination: Self fertile. Height to 2m.

Planting Guide:

- Select a sunny site with fertile soil and good drainage.
- 2. Dig hole about 30cm deep.
- 3. Set tree on hole at same height as planted in bag.
- 4. Fill hole with soil.
- 5. Mulch and water around the base of the tree.
