

Dianella 'Little Devil'

Dianella tasmanica 'Little Devil'

Description

A new form of Dianella selected for its distinctive red new growth and upright habit. A further bonus is the striking display of deep cobalt blue berries after flowering. Another Australian Native, Dianella 'Little Devil' is extremely heat and drought tolerant, hardy and easy care. Because of its ability to cope with adverse sites it is a suitable plant for mass amenity and commercial or public area landscaping projects where little or no maintenance will be required. This plant can also tolerate coastal conditions well

Growing Situation and Care Notes

Will tolerate most soil types and requires little water once established. Will require good drainage if in an irrigated area or in a region with high rainfall. Pest and disease resistant, benefits in appearance by removal of spent flower stems. You can feed in spring with a fertilizer suitable for native plants if desired.
