

Heucherella 'Sweet Tea'

A foliage effect perennial grown to brighten shaded areas. Huge cinnamon stars are surrounded by the loveliest orange tea coloured borders. Undeniably the most intensely coloured Heucherella ever! The big, palmate leaves darken in the summer and lighten up again in the autumn. Its H. villosa breeding gives it a big bold habit and heat and humidity tolerance

Description

Heucherellas are the result of a cross between Heucheras and Tiarellas. As expected from these parents this originates from a woodland plant. Foliage shows variation in depth during the season, being at it's darkest during Summer and Winter. A juvenile plant does not show it's full colour intensity until it is mature so patience will be rewarded with the lovely colours of the fully established plant.

Growing Situation and Care Notes

Grow Heucherella 'Sweet Tea' in part shade to full shade. Ideal combined with the many lovely colour selections of Heucheras, Heucherellas and Tiarellas on the market for colourful shade drama. Protect from intense direct sunlight particularly afternoon sun. Avoid water logged soils, ensure good drainage. Water and feed occasionally with slow release fertiliser. Easy care. Hardy.
