

Inca Alstroemeria 'Pulse'

Description

Inca Alstroemerias have been bred to be an ideal size for the Garden as a mid-height Alstroemeria. These are tall enough to fill out the middle section of a perennials border but are not so tall as to fall over or look untidy. The stems are of sufficient length to cut and last in a vase for around 10 days. A picking garden is a lovely asset and these wonderful Alstroemerias are bred by Konst, a world-leading cut flower and garden Alstroemeria breeder. Inca 'Pulse' is a particularly strong vibrant red, with a neat habit and glorious almost 'fluoro' red flowers. It mixes beautifully with other varieties below, pictured: Inca Alstroemerias 'Adore' and 'Exotica' Other recommended Incas to add to your picking garden are 'Glow' 'Mardi Gras' and the new Inca 'Desert'

Growing Situation and Care Notes

Inca Alstroemerias are bred for compact habit. They are non-invasive unlike older Alstroemerias. Suitable in pots or in the garden they like humus-rich soil, and need to be kept moist through summer months. Remove old spent stems and excess 'blind stems' for repeat flowering. Feed with slow release fertilisers in spring for stunning flowering. Mulch is beneficial where Incas are in garden beds.
