

Lavender 'Ruffles' Series

Description

Lavender 'Ruffles' are a wonderful combination of compact habit and massed flowers in sensational colours, from the traditional to the delicate combination of bicolors. 'Ruffles' are so named because the chunky 'bracts' above the flower heads are distinctively rippled along their margins. Their compact and tidy habit makes these lavenders an ideal choice for smaller garden spaces, containers and hedges. Four 'Ruffles' varieties are available, 'Sugarberry' (combined Mauve and pink), 'Raspberry' (Pink) 'Blueberry' (Deep Mauve/Purple) and 'Boysenberry' (Musky Pink with swirling White centres)

Growing Situation and Care Notes

These Lavenders are hardy, easy care and relatively drought tolerant. A light prune after flowering and again late Summer will maintain their compact good looks. As with many profusely flowering perennials a feed with slow release fertilizer provides benefits in spring.
