

Viola 'Heart Throb'

Description

Viola Heart Throb has a heart shaped deep green leaf with a large central dark accent. Bold foliage with a strongly contrasting deep burgundy splash is the feature of this plant as flowers are plentiful but insignificant. A wonderful and reliable foliage plant known to perform for an extended period and year round in warm temperate areas. Strong textured leaves are attractive in containers, the front of the border, or as a ground cover. Breathtaking when mass planted. Forms a dense foliage mat with leaves pointing up and outwards. Viola 'Heart Throb' does die down in winter emerging in Spring with attractive new foliage

Growing Situation and Care Notes

More sun tolerant than other violas, will nevertheless appreciate some shade in hot climates. Prefers moist well nourished soils. Some protection from slugs and snails may be beneficial. Easy care. Hardy.
